

The Eye of Glass is Broken

Question: What does it mean in Genesis 1:26 when God said, “Let us make man in our image”?

Answer: An image is a mind picture that came from a thought that came from an idea. The image is only a **theory**, until it is proven to be a **reality**. An image is an imagination of a form that a “seed” holds within it. The idea becomes a seed and the “*seed*” evolves in the following sequence:

A **theory** -- as in “theologian” -- the-lo-organ; and Logos (lo-gos, lo gas) is the first stage of the development of an idea. An image is a picture of a thought that follows an idea. The “idea” and the “thought” are the male and female that begot (sired and conceived) the image. The idea, the thought, and the image are one, and **together they become a theory**.

The second stage of a developing seed is a **hypothesis**, or hypothetical. Hypothetically, the theory concerning the image could become a reality.

The third stage of development of the idea is that it now has **possibility**. Hypothetically, the theory has real possibilities.

The fourth stage is a **probability**. The image is beginning to have substance, and the probability of its reality is now more than a possibility or hypothesis.

The fifth stage of development is that the idea is now an **actuality**. The probability (problem) becomes an actuality -- a workable problem. The image that was empty and void is now more than an outline or a drawing of a vessel. The container is beginning to “fill up” with substance by the work of the one whose “container” it is.

After all the lines have been drawn and measured and the price has been calculated and paid, then the realization is known of that which began as only an idea, and then became a thought and later became an image that became (and is) a theory.

I no longer know myself as the image in the mirror of glass, but now I am the silver substance “*behind*” the image in the eye of the mirror. ***I now realize that I am the “Cause” behind the image.***

I now know that I alone am the one who remains after the mirror is broken, because I am the Cause, the genesis of the image. After the glass is shattered, the image, the glass, and the silver are no more. But the time has been well spent playing the “role” of the image. I can now see (realize) myself “face to face” and “eye to eye” without looking into the mirror -- ***the looking glass!*** I realize that unless I am the source (“Cause”) of the idea and the image, I can have no part in the thought or the process leading to its realization.

All that I am, I see; and all that I see, I am. I am the Life, the Light, and the Substance of all Truth. I am in all and all is in me. I will be to all whatever I am thought to be. I am

whatever I think or desire to be, first to myself and then to all men. I am lacking in nothing and nothing is lacking in me.

That which began as an idea became a thought, and then the thought became an image, and the image became a theory. The theory became a Logos, a seed, and afterwards the Logos grew and became a fully developed personality, a "*persona having reality*." Lastly, I -- the "idea" -- became a fully formed Ego. **AN EGO IS A FULLY FORMED PLANETARY MAN!**

My reality is that I am a woman that was a man who is not -- *yet he is*, because I am. I am the body of the man (seed) who is not. I am the Spirit and the Mind of the woman who is the man, who is not. I am the Cause behind the body and I am the Mind who created the body.

The head, the mind, and the body are one. The body and its origin (organs) are the creations of the head and the mind. There is one body with many parts, and they all work together to create the "ONE." Each part is *as* all the other parts, ***functioning and operating as ONE whole Planetary Man***. A Planetary Man is Spirit, Mind, Soul, and Body, all parts being equal.

Each of these four body parts have many sub-parts that depend completely upon all of the other parts of the body. For example, the lungs and heart keep the oxygen and blood flowing to the brain that is necessary to sustain the whole. The lungs and heart in turn themselves depend upon many sub-parts to sustain *their* individual operation. So likewise, every part of the man IS the whole man, just as each drop of water in the ocean IS the ocean. But one drop "alone" is worthless and will evaporate and "be no more" as soon as the heat of the sun's rays touch it. Similarly, when the "Light of Truth" touches the eye of glass, it will be shattered by the Fire of Life and also disintegrate. Therefore, "seeing" alone, without hearing and feeling, is worthless.

A complete man is the Substance of the invisible gaseous image that in the beginning had no form or provable reality, but now he is made real. ***He is the form of that which was formless***. He is the realization of that which was believed and hoped for while he was yet unseen. He is the manifestation of the invisible God in a tangible bodily form of immortal Substance -- indestructible, incorruptible, eternal Truth realized in the likeness of the image, which was originally only a drawing in the Mind. ***THE "MAN" IN THE MIRROR OF THE MIND'S EYE (IDEA) NOW HAS A FULLY FORMED BODY OF SUBSTANCE AND HE IS ALIVE!***

"Let us make man in our image" means to bring forth Substance to fill up the image (container), which is only an outline. He who was the idea *was* the eye (light) alone, without hearing or the touch (feeling) of Life, but now he is the all in one.
