Answer: Dear Jack: I will attempt once again to answer your question regarding God’s requirement of a “blood sacrifice of his son.”

You need to understand that the Bible is a scientific treatise written in a metaphysical language that the “natural mind” cannot understand. It is a book of parables, allegories, word-pictures, etc. Having said this,

and if you can accept this truth, you will then also be able to accept the truth that THERE IS NO DEITY ANYWHERE THAT HAS EVER REQUIRED A “BLOOD SACRIFICE” FROM ANYONE, FOR ANY REASON.

Understanding can only be experienced by one who is ready to leave behind erroneous interpretations of this and all of the parables / allegories of the Holy Scriptures that are provided by “carnally minded religious people.” As I said in my first response to your question, “spiritual words” have meanings that are not comprehended by the natural mind. Please read all of chapter 2 of 1 Corinthians and note verses 7-14 as follows: “But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory: Which none of the princes of this world knew: for had they known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory. But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him. But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God. For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God. Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God. Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual. ***But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.***”

I have explained what different biblical “words” and “phrases” mean in my writings on our website. These can be accessed and downloaded free of charge by anyone who wishes to ***study*** them. It is not possible for you to understand the truth regarding the answer to your question with a “one-liner” answer. Read Romans 12:1-2. This Scripture is speaking of ***the same sacrifice*** described in all the other uses of the term “sacrifice” wherever they are mentioned in the biblical book of allegories and parables. The “sacrifice” that is required is even more openly described in 1 Corinthians 1:17-25. Please note verse 19.

The knowledge and wisdom of a mortal man is the substance of the mortal law that he has ***learned through the avenue of his five senses (sin)***. It is also the substance of his bodily flesh matter. The “spirit of the law” is the life and consciousness of the carnal mind of a man that knows and lives by this knowledge and wisdom. This is the ***mind*** that must be renewed, and the ***body*** is the word of the law that became flesh. This body of the senses was created by the knowledge that came by the exercise of the mortal senses. This body is the ***“bodily sacrifice”*** (knowledge) and the ***“blood”*** (the life and the spirit of the law) that is the ***“acceptable sacrifice.”*** This is the body and the form of the knowledge (doctrine) of the first Adam who came in the likeness of sinful (sensual) flesh that must be destroyed in order to overcome the works and dictates of a man’s mortal senses. The word and the spirit (mind) of the law are the knowledge and power by which the senses were created.

There is no physical death to a man or blood-letting required -- nor is this transformation of the body and the mind the work of a mortal man. ***Rather, it is all a work of the Spirit of the only wise God!***

The only Savior that you or any mortal will ever know is “the Christ (Light of Truth) that is in you” who is your only hope of being renewed in the spirit of your mind, transformed, and begotten again unto a lively hope.

Once again Jack, ***no one has ever died for you or anyone else!*** You -- and you alone -- must die for yourself if you will be ***“saved”*** from the nature of your mortal sins (senses). You must crucify your own sin nature -- “the man of flesh” -- and it is you that must cast out from your consciousness the knowledge that you have learned by the works of your mortal senses, and you must be renewed in the spirit of your

mind. This is accomplished by partaking of the Knowledge of Truth and Life in the Spirit of Christ. This is the “cross” that every man must bear for himself if he will be saved from death to his mortal body.
